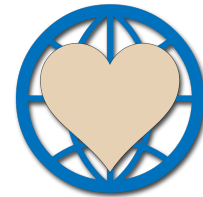

David's biological father died sometimes back and David's mother remarried but his stepfather kicked David out and he went to live with his grandmother but sadly the grandmother died after some months David moved in her house. And David went back to his mother's house where he was being bullied. Because of the bullying that he faces, David's performance at school dropped and final exams to step into another class fails which affects his mother mentally, his mother didn't finish school but she wants her son to be educated.

Penny's journey to Malawi has saved David's future, David was taken to Youth Home in Ntcheu where he lives and continues his education. David is now living happily with his friends and school is going on well.





SOLAR ELECTRIC SYSTEM AND **SECURITY LIGHTS**

In Malawi we experiencing power outages as a result of cyclones we experienced during last year rainy season which resulted in damage of machines at Hydroelectric Power Station and most of the times we do not have electricity, but Momma Penny got us Solar Electric Systems that is helping us a lot; for example, the children read easily at night, the women cook uninterrupted in the kitchen during blackout and the security bulbs are helping the guards to monitor around the campus properly.

Boarding Secondary School Kids



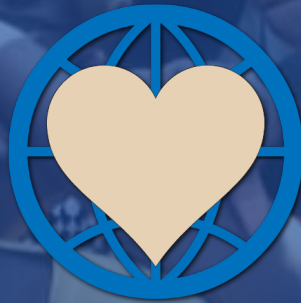
